1930: Death of his father

1939: Mandela's first year at Fort Harare, a

prestigious South African university

1944: Joined the African National Congress (ANC)

1944: Married his first wife, Evelyn Ntoko Mase and divorced her in 1957. Had four children with her

1958: Married Winnie Mandela and divorced her in 1996. Had two children with her

1960: Massacre of 69 peaceful protesters in Sharpeville. The ANC and the PAC (Pan African Congress) banned subsequently

1961: Launching of Umkhonto we Sizwe (Spear of the Nation), the ANC's military wing. Mandela chosen as its leader

1962: Mandela arrested and sentenced to five years imprisonment. Two years later, sentenced to life imprisonment for treason and sabotage. Released after 27 years

1968: Passing away of his mother and son. Mandela kept from attending their funerals

1977: Death of Steve Biko, a leading political activitist, in prison.

1986: Tightening of economic sanctions against the South African apartheid government by the international community

1990: Ban against the ANC lifted. Mandela elected as its leader a year later

1993: Received the Nobel Peace Prize. Shared it with former South African president, F.W. de Klerk

18 July, 1998: Married Graca Machela, widowed wife of Mozambican president, Samora Machel.

1994-1999: Served as first black president of South Africa.

05 December, 2013: Died of lung cancer
