NEGATIVE FORM

I **do not have**/ I don't have

You **do not have**/You don't have

He **does not have**/He doesn't have

She **does not have**/ She doesn't have

It **does not have**/ It doesn't have

We **do not have**/ We don't have

They **do not have**/ They don't have

INTERROGATIVE FORM

I **do not have**/ I don't have

do not have don't have	do not have don't have	does not have doesn't have			do not have don't have		

INTERROGATIVE FORM							
Do	Do	Does			Do

have..?							

TO HAVE

AFFIRMATIVE FORM (+)

FULL FORM	SHORT FORM
I have	I 've
You have	You 've
He } has	He }
She } has	She } 's
It } has	It } 's
We } have	We }
You } have	You } 've
They } have	They } 've

NEGATIVE FORM (-)

FULL FORM	SHORT FORM
I do not have	I don't have
You do not have	You don't have
He } does not have	He }
She } does not have	She } doesn't have
It } does not have	It } doesn't have
We } do not have	We }
You } do not have	You } don't have
They } do not have	They } don't have

EXAMPLES (E.g.)

- *I have a pen.*
- *They don't have any pens.*
- *He has a headache.*
