

## 1. Past Simple to Past Perfect Simple

<u>DIRECT SPEECH</u>: "I met her at secondary school," she said.

<u>INDIRECT SPEECH</u>: She said that she'd met her at secondary school.

## 2. Past Continuous to Past Perfect Continuous

<u>DIRECT SPEECH</u>: "I was expecting her to show up in borrowed clothes," she said.

<u>INDIRECT SPEECH</u>: She said she'd been expecting her to show up in borrowed clothes.

## 3. Past Perfect Simple to Past Perfect Simple

<u>DIRECT SPEECH</u>: "I'd seen her talk to people she barely knew," she said.

<u>INDIRECT SPEECH</u>: She said she'd seen her talk to people she barely knew.

## 4. Past Perfect Continuous to Past Perfect Continuous

<u>DIRECT SPEECH</u>: "I'd been watching TV when this girl arrived," she said.

<u>INDIRECT SPEECH</u>: She said that she'd been watching TV when that girl arrived.
