AFFIRMATIVE FORM (+)

I
You
He/She/It
We
You
They

am
coming

E.g. *I am coming tonight.*
They are coming today.

NEGATIVE FORM (-)

<u>FULL FORM</u>	<u>SHORT FORM</u>
I am not coming.	I'm not coming.
You are not coming.	You aren't coming.
He is not coming.	He isn't coming.
We are not coming.	We aren't coming.
You are not coming.	You aren't coming.
They are not coming.	They aren't coming.
