FULL FORM I will not go there. You will not go there. He will not go there. She will not go there. It will not go there. We will not go there. You will not go there. They will not go there.


SHORT FORM I won't go there. You won't go there. He won't go there. She won't go there. It won't go there. We won't go there. You won't go there.
